HB1311	SMALL GROUP LIMITED HEALTH BENEFIT PLAN
	Rep. Swalm & Sen. Johnson Starting 1/1/2009, requires small employer carriers doing business in the state to offer to small employers that have not offered employer-sponsored health care coverage to their employees or to all classes of their employees within the prior 12 months a limited health benefit plan, as developed by the commissioner of insurance by rule.

HB1327	ACCESS AFFORDABLE HEALTH INSURANCE OUT OF STATE
	Rep. C. Gardner & Sen. S. Mitchell Allows Colorado residents to purchase, and a health insurance carrier, whether or not the carrier is subject to Colorado insurance laws and regulations, to sell in Colorado, a product that is lawfully sold, offered, or issued in another state without subjecting that product to the requirements of Colorado insurance laws and regulations.

HB1341	ALCOHOL SALES TAX CHILDREN BASIC HEALTH
	Rep. Frangas Refers to the voters a measure to authorize a 2% increase in the state sales and use tax on alcohol beverages. In accordance with the state constitution, requires all of the net revenues from the tax increase to be deposited in the old age pension fund, from which they will be credited to the state general fund. The equal amount then appropriated to the children's basic health plan trust.

SB064	INCREASE FOR SUPPL OLD AGE PENSION FUND
	Sen. Sandoval & Rep. Buescher In all future fiscal years, increases the amount allocated to the supplemental old age pension health and medical care fund from the receipts collected from the state sales and use tax. Increases the fund from \$750k to \$2million to increase and stabilize provider reimbursement rates.
